HB 4035

CARRIED OVER FROM 02-11-2014 AGENDA: Allows corrections officer employed by Department of Corrections to lawfully possess weapon in locked gun box in officer's personal vehicle when vehicle is parked in department parking lot and officer is present at department in official capacity.

HB 4036

CARRIED OVER FROM 02-11-2014 AGENDA: Expands crime of assault in the third degree to include, under certain circumstances, causing physical injury to person employed at state mental hospital.

HB 4089

CARRIED OVER FROM 02-11-2014 AGENDA: Limits length of incarceration court may impose when certain probationary sentences are revoked for reasons other than commission of new crime.

HB 4143

CARRIED OVER FROM 02-11-2014 AGENDA: Authorizes court, as part of settlement or judgment in class action, to approve process for payment of damages.

HB 4068

Modifies requirements for concealed handgun license applicants.

HB 4125

Adds reserve officer to category of victims for which aggravated murder can be charged when murder is related to performance of official duties.
