Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 1540 A
Prohibits person or person's affiliate from communicating demand to recipient if in demand person or affiliate alleges, asserts or claims in bad faith that recipient has infringed or contributed to infringing patent or rights that patentee, assignee or licensee has under patent.
- SB 1546 A
Resolves terminology conflict to reflect that offense of endangering welfare of minor through distributing, selling or causing sale of tobacco to minor is Class A violation.

The following measures will be heard after 1:40 p.m.:

- SB 1531 A
Specifies that governing body of city or county may adopt ordinances that impose reasonable regulations on operation of medical marijuana facilities.
- SB 1536 A
Clarifies statutes regarding maintaining and access to "record of the case" and "supplemental confidential file" in juvenile court proceedings.
- SB 1550 A
Requires that criminal trials commence within specified time limits.
