SB 1548
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/10/2014 AGENDA: Amends certain statutes that reference "physician" to include references to "physician assistant" and "nurse practitioner."

Work Session

SB 1526
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/10/2014 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to request federal approval to use Children's Health Insurance Program funds to subsidize costs of commercial health insurance coverage for children with family incomes from 200 percent to 300 percent of federal poverty guidelines.

SB 1542 **
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/10/2014 AGENDA: Allows private payers to hire home care workers through registry maintained by Home Care Commission. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 1560
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/10/2014 AGENDA: Modifies requirements for health plan coverage of telemedical services.

SB 1562
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/10/2014 AGENDA: Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of services, medications and supplies necessary for management of diabetes during pregnancy.

SB 1519
Requires dentist to test, at least once per week, autoclave or other heat sterilization device.

SB 1543
Makes reduction of hours worked by full-time employee for sole purpose of preventing employee's eligibility for coverage under Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act unlawful employment practice.

Work Session

- SB 1553 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Governor to appoint Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator in office of Long Term Care Ombudsman to provide public guardian and conservator services for persons without relatives or friends willing or able to serve as guardians or conservators.
- SB 1569 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and maintain list of designated high priority chemicals of concern for children's health used in children's products.

Possible Work Session

- SB 1523
Requires coverage of applied behavior analysis and treatment of children with pervasive developmental disorder by self-insured plans offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board, Oregon Educators Benefit Board and Oregon Health and Science University.
