HB 4026 A

Requires providers of ignition interlock devices to notify agency or organization that conducted person's diagnostic assessment and person's defense attorney of record of any negative reports downloaded from ignition interlock device.

HB 4035 A

Allows corrections officer employed by Department of Corrections to lawfully possess firearm in locked trunk, glove compartment, center console or other container in officer's personal vehicle when vehicle is parked in department parking lot and officer is present at department in official capacity.

HB 4068 A

Modifies requirements for concealed handgun license applicants.

HB 4114 A

Authorizes court to appoint protected person special advocate in protective proceeding at any time after appointment of fiduciary.

HB 4037

Authorizes county sheriff to designate county juvenile department or Oregon Youth Authority to provide direct transfer of juvenile offenders to youth correction facility as part of agreement with Department of Corrections or supervisory authority of county.

HB 4103 A

Provides that lien claimant's failure to give notice of foreclosure sale to lien debtor with interest in, or to person with security interest in, chattel for which Department of Transportation, State Marine Board or Oregon Department of Aviation requires certificate of title or certificate of registration is unlawful practice under Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

HB 4143 A

Authorizes court, as part of settlement or judgment in class action, to approve process for payment of damages.
