Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4029 A

Authorizes withdrawal of tract from city located within Metro and incorporated between January 1, 2000, and January 1, 2005, if city did not acknowledge comprehensive plan and land use regulations within four years after incorporation and any portion of tract is on boundary of city and within one-half mile of another city.

HB 4111 A

Establishes Public Infrastructure Commission to identify Oregon's public infrastructure funding needs and to research and analyze financing and procurement methods for public infrastructure projects.

HB 4042 A

Adds renewable marine energy to types of energy for which availability of net metering is required.

HB 4142 A

Amends definition of "rural area" to mean area outside urban growth boundary of city of 40,000 or more, as boundary is acknowledged on date on which application is submitted for strategic investment program.

Work Session

HB 4128

Requires that, in election proposing annexation, votes from territory to be annexed and annexing city be counted separately to determine separate majorities if territory is 100 acres or more.
