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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Establishes 13-member task force on school safety comprised of two nonvoting legislators (one Senator, one Representative), an Oregon State Police representative (OSP), a Department of Public Safety Standards and Training representative, and 9 others from or appointed by Governor' office. Sets forth areas of task force concern, including establishment, maintenance and use of database by OSP containing floor plans of all Oregon schools; development of coordinated statewide training for school personnel with other first responders; and studying efficacy of standardized incident response. Directs task force organization to mirror legislative model. Requires reports to a judiciary legislative committee: on school floor plan database by September 1, 2014; and on training and standardized incident response by October 1, 2015. Requires OSP provide task force staff. Requires OSP provide statutory travel expenses. Appropriates general funds to OSP for task force purposes. Sunsets task force upon opening of 2017 legislative session. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
