

- The intention of the amendments to chapter 656, the workers' compensation law, are not intended to substantively modify or change the application of the exclusive remedy protections of that law.
- The bill is drafted to clarify the very limited circumstances when the non-employer of the worker is a public body so they may be sued for wrongful death claims of injured workers.
- This bill is not intended to remove existing rights for workers or their beneficiaries to sue third party private employers.
