Chair Greenlick and Members of the House Committee on Health Care:

O4AD, the Oregon Association of Area Agencies on Aging & Disabilities, is pleased to offer our support of HB 4108, which would institute a pilot project, to repurpose used durable medical equi9pment to medical assistance recipients. O4AD was an active participant in the process to develop this bill for the 2014 legislative session.

We hear about families everyday who have finished use of a piece of durable medical equipment and would like to offer it for donation to be used by another individual. However, there has not been a process in place that would facilitate this type of re-purposing to the benefit of individuals in need. As a volunteer pilot project, durable medical equipment would be repurposed but not with the intent of replacing new equipment. Instead, a pilot offers time to study the potential for repurposing within a limited area of the state to demonstrate the capacity of this type of program for the future.

Families who are facing medical crisis often need many forms of assistance. The ability to help them gain access to the equipment that can make it possible for an individual to remain in their home and community is a worthwhile use of time and effort to study.
