For the record, my name is Bill Wellard, I am the current President of the Oregon Association of Treatment Centers (OATC), and the Executive Director of The Child Center – a non-profit organization that provides intensive community based psychiatric and special education services to children and their families throughout Lane, Deschutes, Crook and Jefferson Counties. The Child Center is a DHS licensed psychiatric day treatment program and as such qualifies for Department of Education funding under the Long Term Care and Treatment (LTCT) education funds. Children in these programs are provided integrated special education and psychiatric or mental health services.

I am here today to voice my support for SB 1528. I am accompanied by Inga Deckert who will focus on SB 1528 and I am going to describe for you the children and families we serve.

Children attend The Child Center and other similar day and residential psychiatric treatment programs throughout the State of Oregon. These

DHS licensed treatment programs have a special education programs funded by the State Department of Education under provisions set forth by the Long Term Care and Treatment rules and regulations. Children are referred to these programs because of their severe mental and emotional disorders. Placement in these programs is highly scrutinized and most of the children receiving services have been reviewed and authorized by the regional Coordinated Care Organization or CCO. Basically the child's behavior or symptoms must be severe enough to warrant this more restrictive placement. Children attend psychiatric day treatment programs for approximately 3 to 6 months while receiving both mental health and special education services.

The attachment to my written presentation has a few graphs that will provide you information regarding the Long Term Care and Treatment Programs and profile data on the children we serve. The data represents approximately 1,840 children who have attended psychiatric day treatment programs statewide. The attachment includes:

- B. Risk Factors
- C. Behavior Characteristics
- D. Admitting Diagnoses

- F. Outcomes

As illustrated by these graphs, the children we serve have serious emotional and behavior disorders and present a very complex set of needs. Providing integrated special education services is of the highest priority. SB 1528 replaces the current arbitrary and inequitable LTCT funding formula with one that is aligned with the State School Fund, placing these children more on par with their peers.

Thank you for giving me this opportunity to voice my support for SB 1528. Inga Deckert will now discuss the Senate Bill in greater detail.

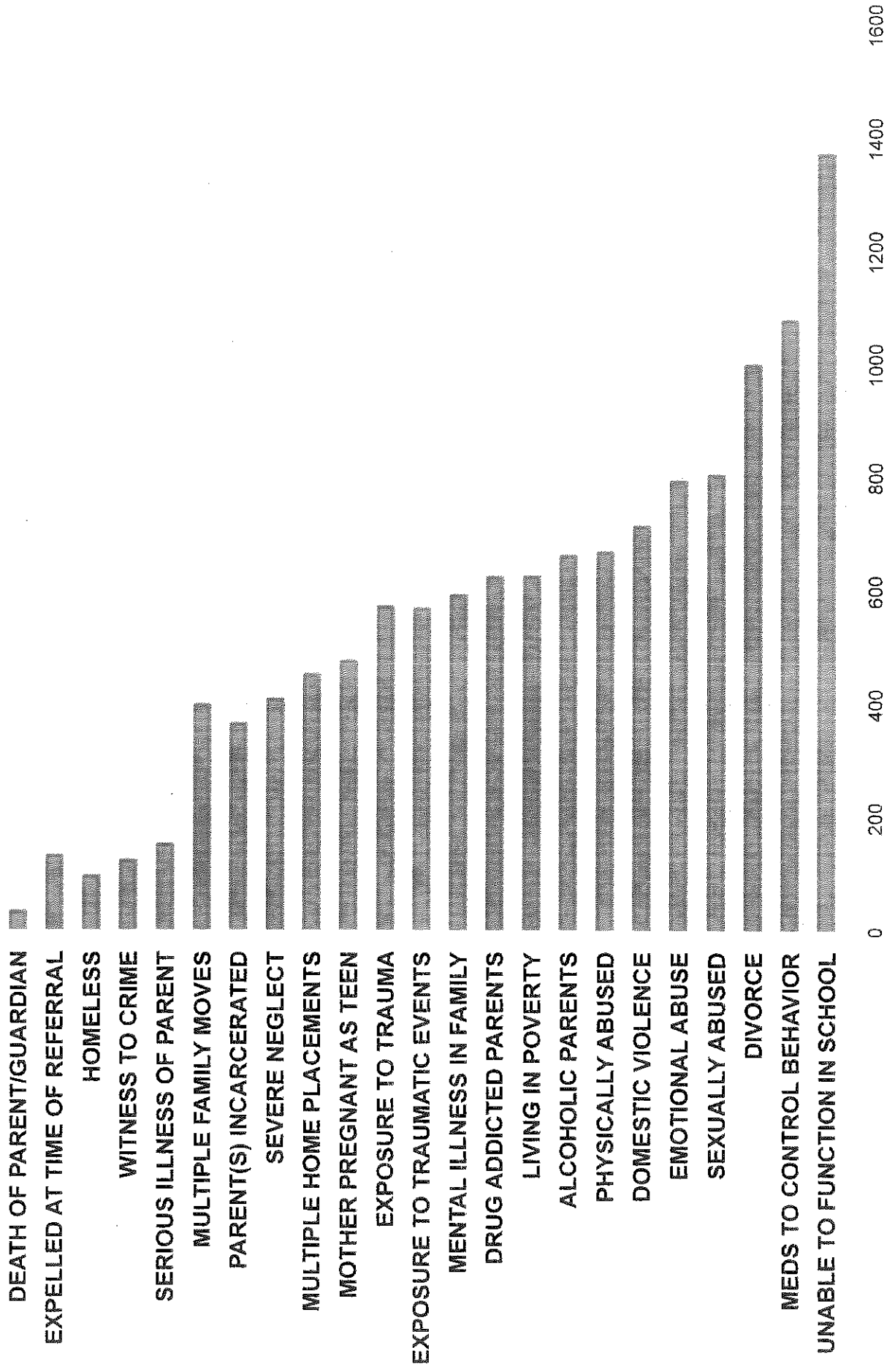

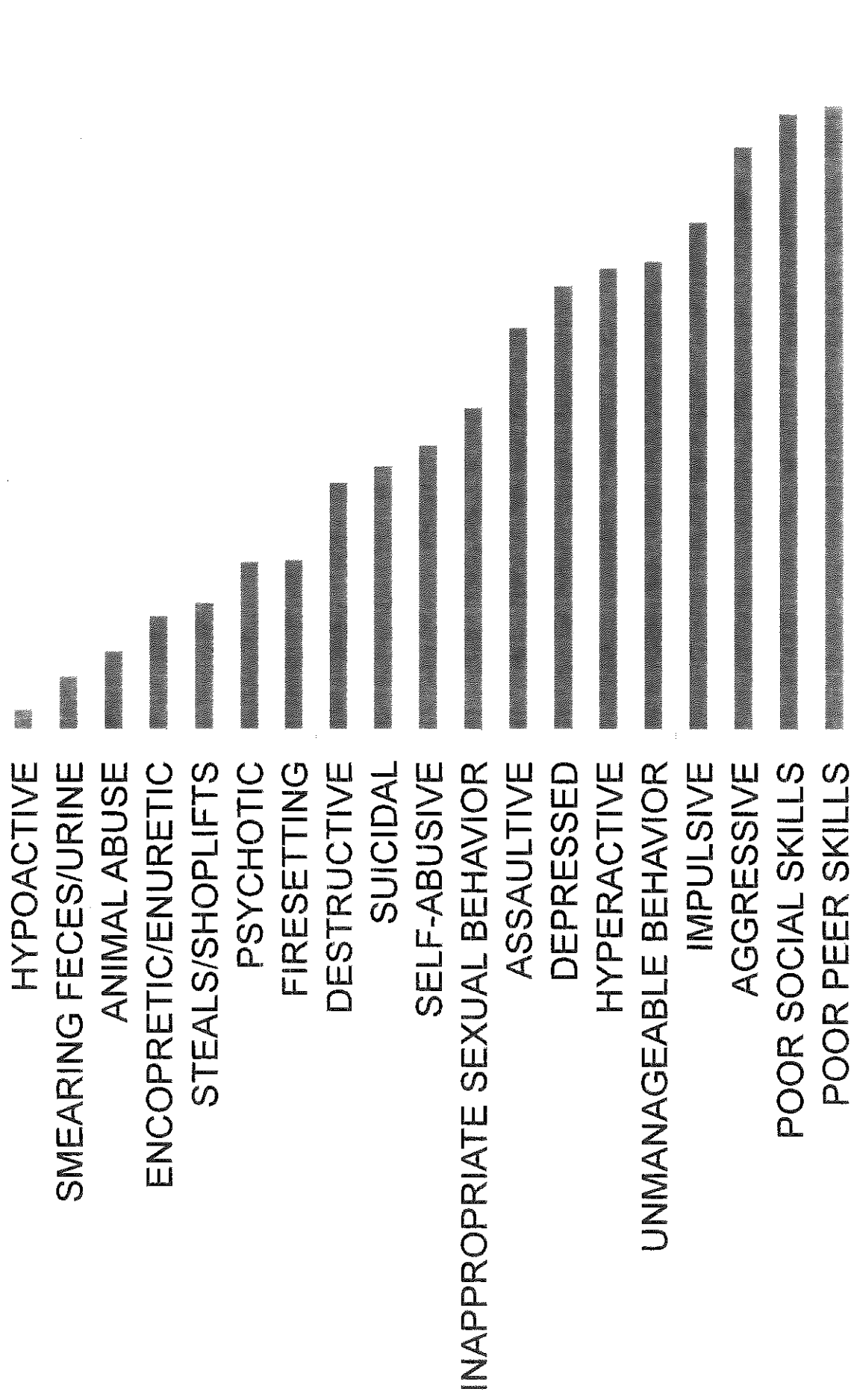

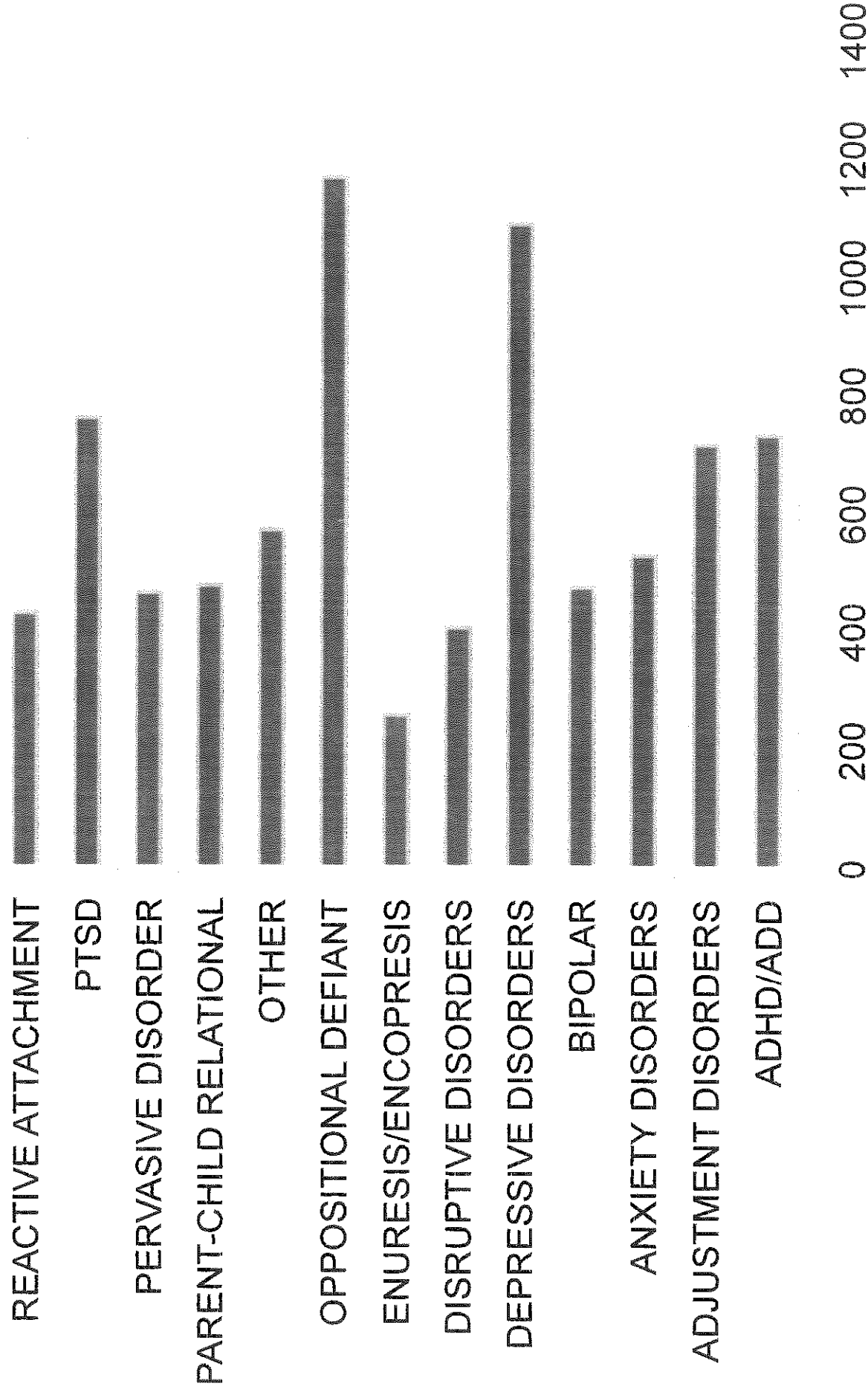
Risk Factors



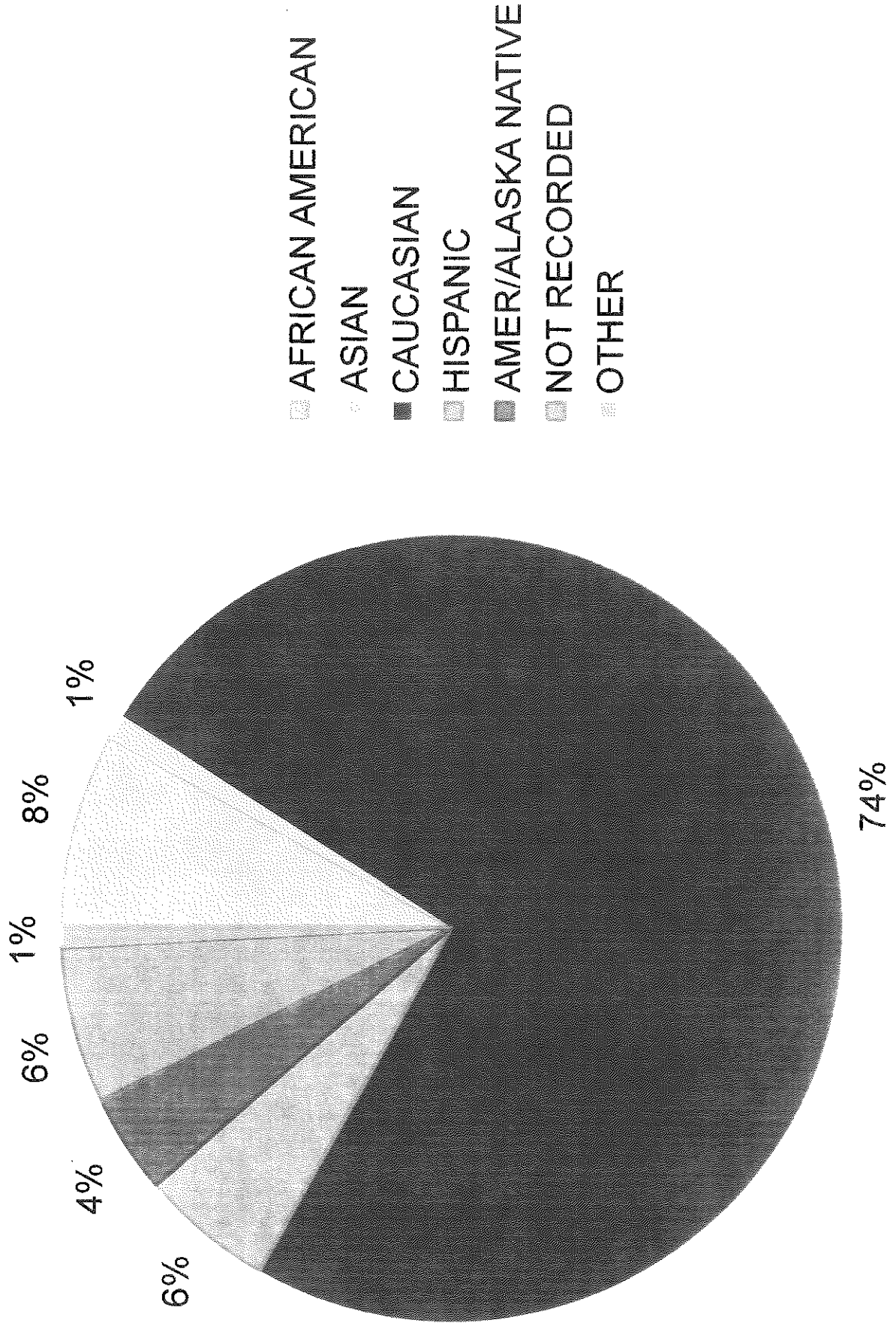
Behavior Characteristics
