Hello Rep. Olson ---

Greetings from LRO... I am assigned to review HB 4072 for possible revenue impacts and I wanted to reach out to you first and give a *very preliminary estimate* of what the revenue impact(s) could be if the bill remains as written.

In the table below, I took the liberty to evaluate some scenarios of: Participation rate in the program at a low-end of 25% and a conservative high end of 75%. The wellness incentive \$ was also reviewed at a low of \$250 versus a high/max of \$500. Additional assumptions that affect these estimates are: Differing participation rates, tax rate of 9% and eligible participants are full and part-time employees.

The table gives a breakdown of estimates of revenue impacts per year and across the 3 successive biennia.
