EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

BACKGROUND: Based on 1999 legislation, the Department of Revenue began sending non-exempt debt to personal collection agencies if more than a year had passed without payment activity. Under its discretionary authority, the Department of Revenue currently sends accounts to personal collection agencies if the location of a debtor is not known or is out of state. Personal collection agencies are also typically used when the department is unable to identify a wage or asset source for the debtor.
