Representatives and Committee Assistant,

Please review current current studies and information before deciding to ban e-cigarette usage outright as if it is smoking. I personally have used an electronic cigarette to quit smoking for almost two years now. I totally understand, and condone the restriction of sales of e-cigarettes to minors. I believe that restricting the usage of e-cigarettes to areas where only smoking is currently allowed will depreciate the value of these devices as a tobacco harm reduction tool.
