Measure Description:

Expands the number of existing enterprise zones eligible for designation as an electronic commerce zone from 10 to 13; extends the sunset date to obtain preliminary certification for tax credit eligibility for renewable energy resource equipment manufacturing facilities; Increases the maximum tax credit amount for qualified research activities to \$2 million from tax year 2013 forward.
