

**Department of Land Conservation and Development  
Information Management Modernization Initiative Report**

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Committee on Ways and Means acknowledge receipt of a report on the Information Management Modernization Initiative (IMMI).

A budget note from the 2013 regular session directed the Department of Land Conservation and Development to work with the Department of Administrative Services in the development of a plan for implementing business and technology improvements to its existing business processes, databases, tools, and applications.

DLCD was appropriated \$238,934 General Fund during the 2013 legislative session for this five year initiative. Total costs for IMMI are still anticipated to be \$1 million, however an additional funding request from the agency is not being sought at this time.

DLCD reported that 24 of the initial projects identified in the initiative have been completed and many other tasks have been started and reside at varying stages of completion. Some of the notable accomplishments of the initiative include the establishment of a governance structure and advisory committee, the modernization and migration of the Farm and Forest database, as well as the Measure 49 database migration.

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends approval of the request.
