**Measure Description:**

Increases number of enterprise zones that may be designated for electronic commerce from 10 to 15; Allows for a property tax exemption for certain property of a history museum, natural history museum, or science museum that was organized prior to January 1, 2010 in a county with population less than 125,000..

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Business Development Department (Business Oregon), Department of Revenue(DOR), Cities, Counties

**Analysis:**
