Measure Description:

Increases amount of moneys allocated from Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to Problem Gambling Treatment Fund. Requires Oregon State Lottery (Lottery) balance obligation to maximize net revenues with obligation to serve public good.

Revenue Impact: The impacts of these programs on the state lottery revenue are not clear and mostly indeterminate.

Impact Explanation:

The effect of changing the overall concentration and mission of the lottery might have an effect on the revenue to the degree relative to the interpretation and success of the new programs. However, the lottery is meant to be for entertainment purposes which might be enough to sustain the interest and the amounts of revenue currently coming to the state. In other words this measure has equal chances of positive or negative impacts on revenue.
