Measure Description:

Requires state agencies to consider certain factors and prioritize funding of projects that affect regional community and economic development and to collaborate with Regional Solutions Program to integrate state investments, services and resources.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Special Districts, Counties, Cities, Statewide

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The Legislative Fiscal Office believes this measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means for consideration of this measure's budgetary impact. This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rural Communities to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Additional information and analysis is needed to determine the impact of staff time (FTE) that state agencies shall provide to regional solutions coordinators, teams and advisory committees.
