Testimony in Favor of HB4116A Joint Committee On Ways and Means Sub-Committee On Education February 24, 2014

Co-Chairs Senator Rod Mon and Representative Bettty Komp and members:

The Oregon Commissions on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs (OCAPIA) and on Black Affairs (OCBA) strongly support HB 4116A which provides grants to Community Colleges for grow participation of underserved students.

The OCAPIA and OCBA know from the collective experience of our commissioners and the people we serve that nothing in this life matters more than the opportunity to be educated. Establishing grant programs to community colleges to increase the number of underserved, first generation and low income students is one of the best investments the State of Oregon can make in its future.

Many who finish community colleges start or buy existing businesses, transfer to four year institutions of higher learning and become pillars in their communities. Students in community college who receive financial support tend to complete college at a higher rate than those students for whom money is a constant challenge. Supporting students in their drive to finish their CC degrees with counselling and financial support is the proven way to build thriving communities of color.
