Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 4047 A-Engrossed establishes the 11-member Task Force on Transportation and Customer Efficiency charged with studying the customer services provided by the ODOT DMV field offices in order to make recommendations on changes and improvements to existing customer service delivery methods. The task force is directed to submit a report to an interim committee by November 1, 2014.

The measure previously had hearings in the House Committee on Transportation and Economic Development on 2/5, 2/10, and 2/12.

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) is directed to provide staff to support the task force. Members of the task force who are not legislators are entitled to reimbursement for travel and other expenses incurred. The bill requires ODOT to pay the reimbursements. Although these cost is indeterminate depending how often and where the task force meets as well as the kind of data the task force will require of ODOT, both DAS and ODOT anticipate using existing staff and resources to support the task force.

The measure is recommended to be moved to the Full Committee on Joint Ways and Means.
