

HB 4108

Relating to durable medical equipment

House Bill 4108 directs the Oregon Health Authority to contract with community organizations to pilot a program to provide used and refurbished durable medical equipment (such as wheelchairs, hospital beds, blood sugar monitors) to medical assistance recipients.

The bill includes a \$75,000 General Fund appropriation to the Oregon Health Authority for the purpose of providing grants to community organizations participating in the pilot project.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends House Bill 4108 be reported out “do pass.”
