

HB 4124

Relating to youth suicide

HB 4124 moves the Youth Suicide Intervention and Prevention Coordinator within the Oregon Health Authority from Public Health to Addictions and Mental Health. It also requires additional activities to develop a statewide Youth Suicide Intervention and Prevention Plan for youth 10 through 24 years of age. The coordinator will report annually to a legislative committee.

A minimal fiscal impact is estimated, and is not funded.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 4124 be reported out do pass.
