Relating to additional support to low-performing Title I schools

House Bill 4117 establishes a grant program administered by the Oregon Department of Education to provide resources for schools that are considered high poverty under federal law, and have been designated by the Department as needing additional support. The funding is to be used for instructional time during the summer months. Each program funded by these grants must provide at least 60 hours of academic instruction by a teacher or educational assistant. The bill includes an appropriation of \$500,000 for the grant program for the remainder of this biennium.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends House Bill 4117 A be amended and reported out do pass, as amended.
