**Subject:** *HB 4110 B*  
Work Session

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HB 4110-B prohibits the denial of reimbursement under a health benefit plan for covered services provided to a person in custody of a county sheriff awaiting disposition of charges or because a person receives publicly funded medical care while in the custody of a sheriff or because the services were provided by an employee or contractor of a county. The measure also expands the definition of "Biosimilar product" to include a biological product that is highly similar to a prescribed biological product and has been approved by the U.S. FDA, and requires the Oregon Health Authority to convene a work group to facilitate a comprehensive discussion of the public policy issues surrounding the limitation of the utilization and scope of health care coverage.

The Work Session packet, including measure, staff measure summary, and amendment are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure has no revenue impact and a minimal fiscal impact.

## Amendment

The B16 amendment to the measure that removes the sections of the bill related to biosimilar products and the workgroup on health care coverage limitations.

The B18 amendment replaces county sheriff with local supervisory authority (as defined in statute) in order to accommodate those Oregon counties where pre-ajudicated persons are held in the custody of a local supervisory authority designated by the board of county commissioners rather than the sheriff. The amendment designates that the minimum reimbursement rate be 115 percent of the Medicare rate as opposed to the amount paid to out-of-network providers as contained in the engrossed bill.

## Measure as Modified
