- Eleven members:
 - Owner-user or employee and representative of owner-user of high pressure boiler in Oregon with practical experience (HOOKER)
 - Manufacturer or employee and representative of manufacturer of boilers or pressure vessels in Oregon (BARSOTTI)
 - Inspector of boilers, and pressure vessels employed by insurer who writes boiler and pressure vessels explosion insurance in Oregon (PITZRICK)
 - Mechanical engineer registered in Oregon (ANDERSON)
 - Boilermaker (ENGSTROM)
 - Owner-user or employee and representative of owner-user of low pressure boiler in this state (LAMB)
 - Owner-user or employee and representative of owner-user of pressure vessels in this state who has practical experience (HILL)
 - Owner or employee of a business engaged in the installation and repair of boilers (ALEXANDER)
 - Steamfitter (STENBERG)
 - Practical steam operating engineer (Boiler Plant Lead Engineer) (MOYER)
 - Public Member (ITOH)
- No member eligible for more than two full terms and the Governor may remove members for cause

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY ORS: 480.535, 480.540, 480.615, 480.645, 480.647 480.665

- Formulate and promulgate rules for the safe construction, installation, inspection, operation, maintenance and repair of boilers and pressure vessels in this state
- Review determinations made by its staff concerning boilers and pressure vessels
- Set safety standards and standards for welding on boilers and pressure vessels
- Hear appeals from appellant who received notice that a restraining order or injunction is sought or that permit has been suspended or revoked
- Hear appeal of appellant with written request to change minimum safety standards or the rules
- Cause standardized examinations to be prepared.
- Meet at least four times per year at time and place specified by Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services after consultation with board
- May adopt rules creating quality control procedures for welding on non-boiler external piping
