Measure Description:

Directs public universities to charge nonresident veteran who is graduate student tuition and fees no greater than resident rate if nonresident veteran received either honorable discharge or general discharge under honorable conditions and provides proof of physical presence in Oregon within 12 months of enrollment.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon Educational Investment Board, Oregon University System (OUS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Veteran's Services and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill would allow nonresident veterans to pay resident tuition for graduate level studies. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
