Measure Description:

Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission to establish lottery game to benefit veterans' education and economic development.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon State Lottery, Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Oregon State Treasurer

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Veterans' Services and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill directs the Oregon State Lottery Commission to establish a raffle game to provide resources for education programs and to support creation of job opportunities for veterans, with sale of tickets to occur on or before July 1, 2015. The Legislative Assembly is directed to allocate an amount equal to the net proceeds from the lottery raffle game to the Department of Community College and Workforce Development for these purposes.

Agencies may have fiscal impacts associated with this bill; the amount of these impacts are still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
