**Measure Description:**

Directs Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development and Higher Education Coordinating Commission to jointly establish grant program for purpose of distributing moneys to community colleges to increase number of underserved, low-income and first-generation college-bound students who enroll in community college and make progress toward degree or certificate.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon Educational Investment Board

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Higher Education and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill appropriates General Fund money to community colleges. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
