Measure Description:

Prohibits public body from obtaining location information of cellular telephone or other electronic communication device without warrant, consent or certain emergent circumstances.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Special Districts, Statewide

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection Committee to the Senate Judiciary Committee.
