Measure Description:

Authorizes Oregon Medical Insurance Pool Board to make expenditures for transitional medical insurance pool program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Consumer and Business Services

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate Bill 1582 authorizes money from the Oregon Medical Insurance Board (OMIP) account to fund transitional medical insurance pool program.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), and the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
