Measure Description:

Requires State Chief Information Officer to appoint Strategic Technology Team within office of State Chief Information Officer.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Efficiency to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires the Chief Information Officer to appoint a Strategic Technology Team to perform advisory and consulting functions; assigns duties and responsibilities to the team; assigns general deliverables and goals; requires report to the Legislature on activities and outcomes of the team by the CIO and the director of the Department of Administrative Services. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
