Measure Description:

Directs Department of Education to make grants to improve student achievement in certain schools that are high poverty and low performing.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

School Districts, Department of Education, Oregon Educational Investment Board

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill directs the Department of Education to make grants to certain schools and appropriates General Fund monies to the Department. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
