WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Permits Oregon State Lottery to use existing dollars allocated for cost of administration to further state policy to minimize risks and mitigate harms of problem gambling.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Social and economic cost of problem gambling
- How state lottery is able to spend its resources

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces the measure.

BACKGROUND: House Bill 4028A clarifies that the Oregon State Lottery has the authority to spend funds consistent with the state's policy in favor of prevention and treatment of problem gambling.
