Measure Description: Directs the Oregon Department of Education to make grants to improve student achievement in low performing Title I schools. Appropriates \$660,000 out of the General Fund for the grant program. Declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.

Impact Explanation: The bill provides grants totaling \$660,000 out of the General Fund to certain Title I schools with low performance so that grants can be used to improve student achievement. As part of the Oregon's Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Flexibility Waiver, the Oregon Department of Education is required to identify certain low performing Title I schools for additional review and support.
