**Measure Description:** Specifies that the Long Term Care and Treatment (LTCT) education programs be funded by way of the formula revenue distribution. Takes effect on July 1, 2014.

**Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):** The bill calls for the LTCT program to give up the General Fund portion of its funding to the State School Fund (SSF) in FY 2014-15. As a result, the SSF will see an increase of its formula revenue by \$7.4 million for the 2013-15 biennium. The bill also specifies that starting from the 2014-15 school year, the program is to be solely funded through the formula revenue distribution. The bill has a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. Further analysis will be done when the bill is in that committee.
