Measure Description:

Authorizes withdrawal of tract from city located within Metro and incorporated between January 1, 2000, and January 1, 2005, if city did not acknowledge comprehensive plan and land use regulations within four years after incorporation and any portion of tract is on boundary of city.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Land Conservation and Development

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
