

**FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION**

**Measure: SB 1526 - A**

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**Measure Description:**

Requires Oregon Health Authority to investigate whether, and under what conditions, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services is likely to approve matching funds from the federal Children's Health Insurance Program for state expenditures used to subsidize costs of commercial health insurance coverage for children with family incomes from 200 percent to 300 percent of federal poverty guidelines.
