**Measure Description:**

Requires providers of radio communications service for cellular devices to provide, at request of law enforcement agency, call location information of cellular device for purpose of responding to 9-1-1 emergency call or emergency involving risk of death or serious physical harm; requires the Office of Emergency Management to collect and report the disclosure of call location information to the Legislative Assembly; indemnifies providers that provide call location information in good faith when requested.

**Analysis:**
