WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Makes dual-credit options available to students in any grade from 9 through 12.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Process of moving from high school to college in a forward direction
- Desire to expand access to college credits for all high school students by explicitly stating grade levels at which students can pursue college credit in high school

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces the measure.

BACKGROUND: Current law does not specify an age of access for students seeking to earn college credit after completion of a course in high school.
