Measure Description:

Requires person to request criminal background check before transferring firearm to any other person.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon State Police, Public Defense Services Commission, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Department of Corrections

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Judiciary Committee to the Senate Rules Committee.
