WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Prohibits medical marijuana operations within 1,000 of a pre-school as well as an elementary, secondary or career school. Regulates the sale of food containing marijuana. Requires certain specific packaging. Prohibits packaging that is attractive to minors. Directs the Oregon Health Authority in adopting rules to enforce these provisions to consider standards under the federal Poison Prevention Packaging Act.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Food containing marijuana is harmful to children
- Safe packaging

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE MINORITY AMENDMENT: Replaces the bill.

BACKGROUND: ORS 475.304 directs the Oregon Health Authority to establish by marijuana grow site registration system to authorize the production of marijuana by marijuana card holders or their caregivers. ORS 475.314 directs the health authority to establish by rule a medical marijuana facility system to authorize the transfer of useable marijuana from a marijuana cardholder, caregiver or person responsible for the marijuana grow site to a medical marijuana facility or from a medical marijuana facility to a medical marijuana cardholder or caregiver.
