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Measure Description:

Requires providers of radio communications service for cellular devices to provide, at request of law enforcement agency, call location information, or best available location information of cellular device for purpose of responding to 9-1-1 emergency call or emergency involving risk of death or serious physical harm; requires the Office of Emergency Management to collect and report the disclosure of call location information to the Legislative Assembly; indemnifies providers that provide call location information in good faith when requested.
