

**FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION**

**Measure: SB 1562 - B**

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**Measure Description:**

Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of services, medications and supplies necessary for management of diabetes during pregnancy. Requires state agencies to provide to the executive director of the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation any reports or findings resulting from an independent review, investigation or audit of the development, implementation or quality control of the health insurance exchange, if review, investigation or audit is contracted for or paid for, in whole or in part, by a state agency. Requires executive director of the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation to appear before the Interim House Committee on Health Care and the Interim Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services.

**Analysis:**
