**Measure Description:**

Requires providers of ignition interlock devices to notify agency or organization that conducted person's diagnostic assessment of any negative reports downloaded from ignition interlock device.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
