

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4023

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert “appropriating  
2 money;”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 36 through 45 and delete page 3 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2014 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 461.**

5 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall establish a lottery raffle  
6 game:**

7 **“(a) That has a veteran-oriented theme or indicates that the proceeds benefit veterans’  
8 education and economic development related to veterans; and**

9 **“(b) For which the limited sales period for tickets may include Veterans Day.**

10 **“(2) The commission shall separately record and account for the costs and net proceeds  
11 of the lottery raffle game described in this section.**

12 **“(3) When transferring net proceeds from the Oregon State Lottery Fund established in  
13 ORS 461.530 for deposit in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund estab-  
14 lished in ORS 461.540, the commission shall certify to the Joint Committee on Ways and  
15 Means established under ORS 171.555 the amount of the transfer that represents the net  
16 proceeds of the lottery raffle game described in this section.**

17 **“(4) The Legislative Assembly shall allocate from the Administrative Services Economic  
18 Development Fund an amount equal to the net proceeds of the lottery raffle game described  
19 in this section for transfer to the Veterans’ Lottery Fund established in section 4 of this 2014  
20 Act to benefit veterans’ education and economic development related to veterans.**

21 **“SECTION 4. The Veterans’ Lottery Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate  
22 and distinct from the General Fund. Earnings on moneys in the Veterans’ Lottery Fund  
23 must be credited to the fund. All moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the  
24 Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for the purposes described  
25 in section 5 of this 2014 Act.**

26 **“SECTION 5. The Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development by  
27 rule shall establish a program to provide opportunities for, or facilitate, the education and  
28 training of veterans, the creation of jobs for veterans and economic development opportu-  
29 nities that benefit veterans.**

30 **“SECTION 6. The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall begin the sale of tickets for the  
31 lottery raffle game described in section 3 of this 2014 Act on or before July 1, 2015.**

32 **“SECTION 7. (1) As used in this section, ‘service’ and ‘uniformed service’ have the  
33 meanings given those terms in ORS 659A.082.**

34 **“(2) A private, nonpublic employer may give preference in the hiring and promotion of  
35 employees to:**

1       “(a) A person who is performing, or has performed, service in the uniformed service;

2       “(b) If a person has performed service in the uniformed service and has been determined  
3 by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs to be permanently and totally disabled  
4 as the result of enemy action or a service-related accident, the spouse of the person; and

5       “(c) The widow or widower of a person who performed service in the uniformed service.

6       “SECTION 8. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect  
8 on its passage.”.

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
