SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Allows corrections officer employed by Department of Corrections to lawfully possess firearm in locked trunk, glove compartment, center console or other container in officer's personal vehicle when vehicle is parked in department parking lot, department has not provided secure storage for firearms owned by officers and officer is present at department in official capacity.

[Declares emergency, effective on passage.] Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to possession of a weapon by a corrections officer; and prescribing an effective date. $\mathbf{2}$

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2014 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 166.360 to 4 166.380. 5

SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 162.135 and 162.185 or any Department of Cor-6 rections regulation, rule, policy or provision of an employment contract to the contrary, if 7 the department has not provided a secure and locked location for storing firearms owned by 8 corrections officers, a corrections officer employed by the department may possess a firearm 9 in the officer's personal vehicle when the vehicle is parked in a department parking lot if the 10 11 officer:

12(a) Is present in the officer's official capacity at a public building occupied by the de-13 partment;

(b) Has a valid concealed handgun license issued pursuant to ORS 166.291 and 166.292; and 14 (c) Has secured the firearm in a closed and locked trunk, glove compartment, center 15 console or other container, and the key is not inserted into the lock, if the trunk, glove 16

17 compartment, center console or other container locks with a key.

(2) As used in this section, "corrections officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS 18 181.610. 19

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2014 Act applies to employment contracts entered into or 20renewed on or after the effective date of this 2014 Act. 21

SECTION 4. This 2014 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2014 2223regular session of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
