## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Fish and Wildlife for study on effects of cormorant predation on juvenile salmonids.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
6	ated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013
7	out of the General Fund, the amount of \$, which may be expended for a study on the
8	effects of cormorant predation on juvenile salmonids.
9	SECTION 2. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect
11	on its passage.
