

House Bill 4053

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rules for Oregon State Bar)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies biennial distribution to Legal Aid Account from amounts collected as fees and charges in circuit courts.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Legal Aid Account; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 9.577.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 9.577 is amended to read:

5 9.577. (1) The Legal Aid Account is established in the General Fund of the State Treasury. All
6 moneys in the account are continuously appropriated to the State Court Administrator for the pur-
7 pose of the distributions required by this section. Interest earned by the account shall be credited
8 to the General Fund.

9 (2) Each month, the State Court Administrator shall transfer to the Legal Aid Account, from
10 amounts collected by the State Court Administrator as fees and charges in the circuit courts, the
11 amounts necessary to make the distributions required by subsection (3) of this section.

12 (3) Each biennium, the State Court Administrator shall distribute to the Oregon State Bar
13 [*\$11.9*] \$__ million from the Legal Aid Account. Distributions under this section shall be made by
14 the State Court Administrator in eight quarterly installments of equal amounts[, *with the first dis-*
15 *tribution to be made as soon as possible after July 1, 2011*]. Amounts distributed to the Oregon State
16 Bar under this subsection may be used only for the funding of the Legal Services Program estab-
17 lished under ORS 9.572.

18 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 9.577 by section 1 of this 2014 Act apply only to
19 distributions from the Legal Aid Account made on or after July 1, 2015.
