

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4054

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert
2 “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 25.

4 Delete pages 2 through 7 and insert:

5 “**SECTION 1. The ballot title for chapter 48, Oregon Laws 2013 (Enrolled Senate Bill 833),**
6 **as referred to the people by referendum petition for their approval or rejection at the No-**
7 **vember 2014 general election, shall be:**

10 **ESTABLISHES LIMITED PURPOSE, DURATION DRIVER CARD FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO**
11 **PROVE OREGON RESIDENCY, MEET DRIVING REQUIREMENTS.**

13 **RESULT OF “YES” VOTE: “Yes” vote establishes limited purpose, limited duration driver**
14 **cards, issued to applicants with valid identification, who prove Oregon residency, pass driver**
15 **tests, pay card fees.**

17 **RESULT OF “NO” VOTE: “No” vote rejects issuing limited purpose, limited duration driver**
18 **cards to applicants with valid identification, who prove Oregon residency, pass driver tests,**
19 **pay card fees.**

21 **SUMMARY: Current law authorizes State of Oregon to issue driver license to individual who**
22 **demonstrates current Oregon residency, safe driving ability and other enumerated require-**
23 **ments.**

25 **Measure authorizes the state to issue limited purpose driver card to individual who demon-**
26 **strates safe driving ability, provides proof of identity and proof of Oregon residency for more**
27 **than one year, without requiring proof of legal presence in the United States. Driver card**
28 **may be used only for the grant of driving privileges, to provide a driver identification number**
29 **and to identify driver as a veteran, anatomical donor or emancipated minor. Driver card**
30 **must contain feature to distinguish card from driver license. Driver card is valid for four**
31 **years instead of eight years for driver license. Measure specifies fees. Other provisions.**

34 “**SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 250.035, 250.065, 250.067 and 250.085, the ballot title**
35 **prepared under section 1 of this 2014 Act shall be the ballot title printed in the voters’**

1 pamphlet and printed on, or included with, the ballot. A petition seeking a different ballot
2 title may not be filed with the Supreme Court under ORS 250.085 or otherwise.

3 “(2) The ballot title for chapter 48, Oregon Laws 2013 (Enrolled Senate Bill 833), provided
4 by the Attorney General under ORS 250.065 and certified by the Attorney General under ORS
5 250.067 (2) is void and may not be printed in the voters’ pamphlet or printed on, or included
6 with, the ballot. Any Supreme Court review under ORS 250.085 of the ballot title prepared
7 or certified by the Attorney General for chapter 48, Oregon Laws 2013 (Enrolled Senate Bill
8 833), is moot and terminated.

9 “SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect
11 on its passage.”.

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
