SUMMARY

Amends 40-40-20 education goals to include apprenticeship programs registered with State Apprenticeship and Training Council.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 351.009 is amended to read:
5	351.009. (1) The Legislative Assembly declares that the mission of all education beyond high
6	school in Oregon includes achievement of the following by 2025:
7	[(1)] (a) Ensure that at least 40 percent of adult Oregonians have earned a bachelor's degree
8	or higher;
9	[(2)] (b) Ensure that at least 40 percent of adult Oregonians have earned an associate's degree
10	or a post-secondary credential as their highest level of educational attainment; and
11	[(3)] (c) Ensure that the remaining 20 percent or less of all adult Oregonians have earned a high
12	school diploma, an extended or modified high school diploma or the equivalent of a high school di-
13	ploma as their highest level of educational attainment.
14	(2) The earning of a post-secondary credential described in subsection (1)(b) of this sec-
15	tion may be satisfied by adult Oregonians who have completed apprenticeship programs
16	registered with the State Apprenticeship and Training Council.

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
