SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Amends 40-40-20 education goals to include apprenticeship programs registered with State Apprenticeship and Training Council.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to apprenticeship programs in Oregon's education mission; amending ORS 351.009.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 351.009 is amended to read:

5 351.009. The Legislative Assembly declares that the mission of all education beyond high school
6 in Oregon includes achievement of the following by 2025:

7 (1) Ensure that at least 40 percent of adult Oregonians have earned a bachelor's degree or
8 higher;

9 (2) Ensure that at least 40 percent of adult Oregonians have earned an associate's degree,
10 **completed an apprenticeship program that is registered with the State Apprenticeship and**
11 **Training Council** or **earned a** post-secondary credential as their highest level of educational at-
12 tainment; and

13 (3) Ensure that the remaining 20 percent or less of all adult Oregonians have earned a high
14 school diploma, an extended or modified high school diploma or the equivalent of a high school di-
15 ploma as their highest level of educational attainment.

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
